Skills Needed/Preferred

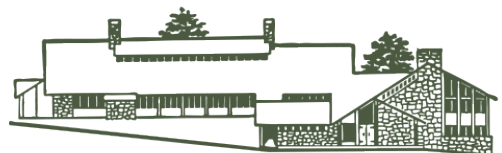
- Ability to work cooperatively with a team, as well as independently.
